

USE OF DB LOUNGES BY HOLDERS OF FIP TRAVEL FACILITIES

As an extra service in its busiest stations, DB-AG has established DB Lounges. The stations concerned are:

Use of the lounges by holders of FIP travel facilities is restricted to those holding the following 1st class tickets:

- Personal International Free Pass
- Impersonal (Bearer) Free Pass
- International Coupon stamped 'Duty Journey'.

Use of the 1st class section of the lounges (found only at Berlin Hbf, Frankfurt/Main Hbf, Hamburg Hbf and München Hbf) is **not** permitted.

Those accompanying holders of the above-mentioned tickets may use the lounges on payment of €10.

If the lounges are exceptionally busy, holders of the above FIP facilities may be asked not to make use of the lounges, in the same way that holders of FIP facilities can be asked to vacate seats in busy trains. The Lounge personnel determine whether access is permitted in such circumstances.

Please note that use of the lounges by holders of any other 1st class FIP documentation (eg for leisure travel) is **not** permitted.
