

**DID YOU KNOW: RAIL TRAVEL IN HUNGARY is FREE for those aged 65+**

In accordance with legislation in Hungary (Government Decree 85/2007 (IV.25.)) citizens of the EU, Norway and Switzerland aged over 65 are entitled to free travel on Standard Class domestic services on the lines of MÁV and GYSEV.

This domestic discount is not available for use on trains entering or leaving Hungary (cross-border journeys).

This discount is valid only against the fare: it does not cover any supplements. So if you are using a specially priced service train (eg InterCity) any supplement or reservation due still has to be paid for.

If you wish to travel in 1st class, the difference between the 1st and the 2nd class fare can be paid.

Proof of age and of nationality is provided by your passport.

However, you cannot just turn up at a train, wave your passport and board. Before commencing your journey, a free "registration ticket" indicating your destination has to be obtained at the ticket counter.
